This month's featured site from our [Links](#) page is of particular interest to the bards and music lovers among us: Cantaria (<http://www.chivalry.com/cantaria/>).

Cantaria is a library of "bardic" folk songs, mostly from Ireland, Scotland, and England, intended to be an educational tool for propagating the living song tradition through passing on folk songs. Cantaria is unique among lyric web sites because almost every song in the archive has an accompanying recording of the song being performed.

The library currently contains lyrics for over 225 songs. Recent additions include a pair of traditional songs (Barbara Allen and Ash Grove) and an outstanding original piece, Rogue of Dundee, all submitted by Leza Messiah, and upgraded versions of I Care Not For These Ladies, Wild Rover and Wild Mountain Thyme, submitted by Stargate's own Andrew Scarhart.



Directions from I-45: Take the Spring Cypress / FM 2920 exit off I-45. Go west on FM 2920 about 13 miles to Hwy 249. Do not turn, continue on 2920 about 8 miles, to Robert's Cemetery turn right, go 3 miles to the Stop sign. Turn left on Magnolia/Nichols sawmill road and go 1.5 mile to clear creek and turn right. Camp Camwood's entrance is a short way down on the right.

Directions from Hwy 290: From 290, exit FM 2920 Go East, toward Houston for approximately 1/2 miles and turn left onto Hegar Rd.. Turn right and proceed 5.5 miles to the intersection with Magnolia road bear right onto Magnolia road, go 2.4 miles to Clear Creek rd. turn left. Camp Camwood is a short way down on the right.

Turn left into the parking lot, and look for us in the field next to the parking lot. It is a controlled-access faculty/staff parking lot, but is open after about 6 pm. Most practices focus on individual instruction and tournament (one-on-one) style combat, but the first Tuesday of each month is devoted to practicing melee skills and small unit tactics.
