The Historical Happenings



A Historical account from our Historian, Mistress Annes:

Greetings Unto the Populace!

Coronation was held this last weekend in Emerald Keep. It was an amazingly hot day and the site was in Reisel, TX at the Lions Park hall.

Another piece that I bid on was a bracelet/necklace set also donated by Her Grace. I wanted this because she wore it at the event in March of 1976 where our Kingdom's name was decided. Annes Pashka

Pashka is a Russian dessert cheese. But it somehow ends up tasting like nothing you have ever had except absolutely yummy.

Ingredients:

½ lb. Of butter-I use salted.

½ lb. Of cream cheese

1 lb. Of ricotta cheese

1 cup of sugar

1 TBS. vanilla

Flavoring of your choice such as:

2 or 3 TBS. Cinnamon (my favorite)

½ can of blueberry pie filling (very good)

½ can of any other pie filling (very good also)

Lots of fresh strawberries and ½ cup of strawberry jam (really good)

To Prepare:

Put everything in a BIG bowl. Wash your hands really good and then squish and mash everything with your hands until creamy and smooth. Add the flavoring of your choice first and mix thoroughly. Chill for at least 1 hour...better over night.

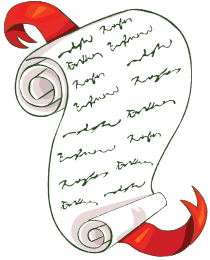
To Serve:
