Fedelm ni Uidhir

Snow scenes and stories in Stargate? One activity to help tell stories about snowy days is to make a snow scene. You can use a large plant saucer or shallow box, and use common table salt to create a snow area. We used to use tiny wooden houses and other toys in telling stories like "Katy and the Big Snow" and pile up the snow drifts to bury the houses. A period story to tell might involve the "Birch Legs" of Norway, skiing over the mountains with the infant prince Haakon (IV) from one hiding place to another, to keep him safe from his enemies. A box or two of salt costs very little, and you can use paper clips for snowshoes or make craft stick skis (or snow boards!) for your small action figures. If you want to know more about the "Birch Legs", you can check them out on line (or try Birkebeiner, to avoid the furniture hits!).
