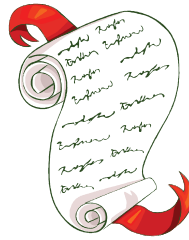
From the Seneschal

A TART WITH FRESH PLUMS

From The Cookbook of Sabina Welserin (c. 1553)

Due to the nature of this particular event and feast; I decided to do a period recipe that would be tasty, and use fruits of the season. The Cookbook of Sabina Welserin is an excellent source that is used by many cooks throughout the known world and is one of the earliest cookbooks written by a woman. There are in fact two plum tart recipes that are referenced.

The primary recipe with English translation is noted below:



Ain andere torten von grenen pflamen

Thiet die stain sauber herausß vnnd schneits jn der mit auff vnnd macht die torten vnnd set zúcker vnnd relach an boden vnnd legt darnach die pflamen aufs allernechst zúsamem vnnd thiet wider zúcker vnnd relach darauff, thiet auch ain wenig pútter darauf, macht arnach den dortentaig jn masß, wie er verzeichnet jst no [70].

Another tart with fresh plums

Take the stones cleanly out and cut them open in the middle and make the tart and sprinkle sugar and cinnamon on the bottom crust and after that lay the plums as closely together as possible and put sugar and cinnamon on them again. Put also some butter thereon. Make after that the tart dough in the manner which is recorded in number [seventy]

In order to allow for documentation of the pastry as well, I have included the referenced recipe below.

70. Ain torten von pflamen, sý seýen dir oder gren

Last sý vor sieden jn ainem wein vnd treibs dúrch vnnd nim air, zimerrlach, úcker, laß bachem den taig zu der torten, hept man also an, man nimpt 2 air vnnd erklopffts, darnach riert ain mel daran, bis es dich wirt, schit jn darnach auff den disch vnnd arbeit jn woll, bis er recht wirt, hernach nempt ain wenig mer dan den halbtail vom taig vnnd welglet ain blatz, so brait jr die torten haben welt, hernach schit die pflamen darauff vnnd welglet hernach den andern blatz vnnd zerschneit jn, wie jr jn geren haben welt, vnnd thiets oben jber die torten vnnd zwicklens woll zúsamem vnnd lasts bachem, also macht man all tortentaig.

70. A tart with plums, which can be dried or fresh

Let them cook beforehand in wine and strain them and take eggs, cinnamon and sugar. Bake the dough for the tart. That is made like so: take two eggs and beat them. Afterwards stir flour therein until it becomes a thick dough. Pour it on the table and work it well, until it is ready. After that take somewhat more than half the dough and roll it into a flat cake as wide as you would have your tart. Afterwards pour the plums on it and roll out after that the other crust and cut it up, however you would like it, and put it on top over the tart and press it together well and let it bake. So one makes the dough for a tart.

The Arts continued

HL Mea's Redaction.

For the pastry:

2 eggs

1.5 C Flour

For the Filling:

2 lbs small plums

1 C Sugar

2 Tbsp Cinnamon

2 Tbsp Butter

For this recipe, I decided to bake at about 375 degrees since that is a common temperature for a fruit pie/ tart. For the most part, I followed the recipe as specified. The dough for the pastry is tougher and much sturdier compared to the sugar pastries used in later period and modern day recipes. This is often referred to as Pate Sucree. When preparing the filling, I simply took a hand full of sugar and mixed it with cinnamon to coat the bottom of the crust. In preparing the plums, I decided to cut them into wedges since the recipe stated to put the plums together as closely as possible. I then took the remaining sugar, added cinnamon, and mixed it with the plums. I admit to doing this more out of habit than anything else. I knew the juices of the plums would already begin mixing with the sugar thus creating a thick kind of glaze when cooked. I then dotted the tart with the butter and set it to bake. I also turned away from adding the top crust, mainly because I wished to be able to monitor the cooking better. It cooked for about 45 minutes with my checking it regularly and praying that it would not over brown.

Things I have taken from this little experiment...

The first thing that I realize is that cooks in the 1500s would not have used as much sugar as I did. Again I think this is more due to the modern taste of things. I feel as if I had just sprinkled it over the top as indicated, then it would not have turned out as sweet to taste, and therefore not be as appealing. The german tarts from this time seem to be similar to single crust country tarts or crostadas that are commonly made in Italy.

Over all I feel that this must have been a simple recipe for the time period. The challenge for the modern day cook will mostly be in the interpretation and testing stages.
