## Pomanders

I will have my pomander of most sweet smell, Also my chains of gold to hange about my necke."

"Brooke of Robin Conscience" (about 1600)

Pomanders have been used by people for hundreds of years to carry fragrances on their persons. They were used to sweeten the air and to ward off disease believed to be caused by bad air (foul odors). Beeswax was impregnated with ambergris, musk, or civet and carried in round or apple shaped containers with grills or perforations, suspended from the belt, girdle or neck chain. Among the wealthy, these containers were usually of gold or silver and frequently ornamented with precious gems. One found in the Thames is in the collection of the British Museum.

To make your own pomander, take a cake of beeswax and shave off a few pieces. Work the pieces in your hands until it warms and softens. This will not work if your hands are cold. Add a drop or so of essential oil, such as clove, cinnamon, musk or your favorite. Continue until you have a ball at least the size of a walnut. Wash your hands well. Some of the essential oils can burn the eyes if you get the oil in them. The wax ball can be carried in a cloth bag or a wood or metal box with perforations.

A non-period pomander, but one fun to make with your children, requires an apple, orange, lemon or lime, whole cloves, powdered orrisroot, cinnamon, ground cloves, ground nutmeg and ground allspice. If you want to hang the pomander, wrap ribbon around the fruit as a cage and mark the placement. No cloves will go in these areas. Use a toothpick, skewer or knife to prick the fruit and insert the whole cloves.

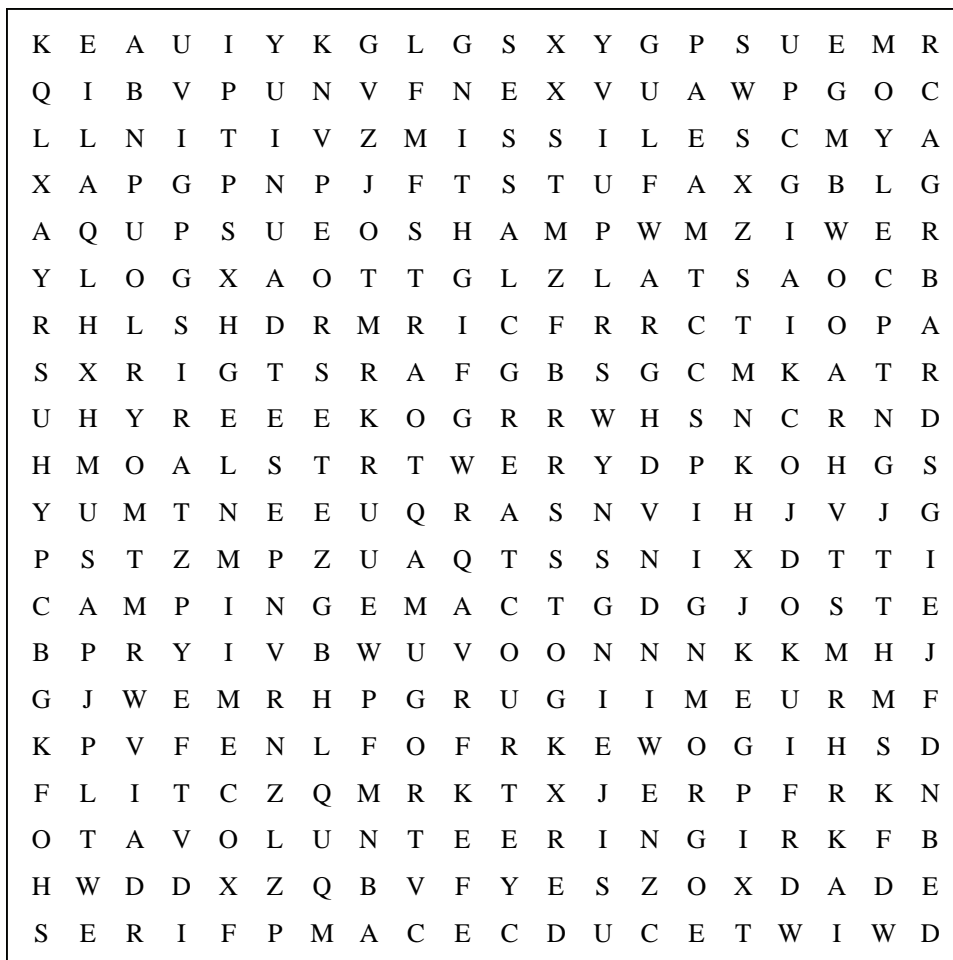
The whole fruit, excluding the areas to be covered by the ribbons, should be covered with cloves. Roll in a mixture of the other spices daily for a week and then add the ribbon. If preferred, the ribbon can be omitted and the pomander put in a drawer to scent the contents or in a bowl in the room for a very holiday scent. The pomander may be refreshed by rolling in the spice mixture or by a few drops of essential oils. They also make good gifts.

Basic recipe:

- 7-8 pieces of fruit
- 1/2 pound of whole cloves
- 1/4 cup ground cinnamon
- 1/4 cup ground cloves
- 2 tablespoons ground nutmeg
- 2 tablespoons ground allspice
- 1/4 cup powdered orrisroot

# Charter for the Stargate Tower Watch

**Name:** Those serving under this charter shall be known collectively as the Stargate Tower Watch (or less formally and hereinafter as The Watch). Persons serving shall be known by their rank and the Words “of the Watch.”

**Purpose:** The purpose of The Watch is to provide an opportunity for real service to the Barony, Baron and Baroness, and visiting dignitaries while increasing persona play and ambiance at events and other gatherings.

**Duties:** The duties of The Watch shall include:

- ceremonial support during Court and Processions;
- escort to the Baron and/or Baroness and to such visiting dignitaries, as required by the Baron and/or Baroness;
- aid the general populace as their other duties permit;
- guard the Baron and/or Baroness or such other visiting dignitaries, as needed;
- act as good will ambassadors for the barony at events and other gatherings;
- such other and further duties consistent with their purpose as may be assigned by the Baron and/or Baroness

**Structure:** Initially, The Watch shall be organized as follows:

- One Captain of the Watch
- Two units under the Captain each led by a Lieutenant
- Two Sergeants in each unit under the Unit Lieutenant
- Three Halberdiers under each Unit Sergeant

In the event that the current number of units proves insufficient to perform the duties of the Watch, additional units may be added.

**Requirements for serving:** Any paid SCA member who has been active within the Barony of the Stargate (1) for at least one year may apply to serve in The Watch. To serve, a person must be of good reputation, shown a willingness to serve those of higher and lower station, and have conducted him or her self with honor and dedication. In special circumstances, the activity requirement of one year may be waived.

Those who will serve will be chosen by the Baron and Baroness, with council from the Captain of the Watch.

**Application:** Application to The Watch shall be by letter of application delivered to the Baron & Baroness and the Captain of the Watch written in a manner appropriate to the applicant's time and culture. The letter should introduce the applicant explaining his or her merits, qualities and qualifications.

---

(1) It is not necessary that a person live within the zip codes assigned to Stargate to be considered an active member.

**Uniforms:** The uniform of The Watch shall be based on a modified vestimenta, sable and argent, with towers sable and argent counterchanged on the sleeves, and one the back, on a pile sable, a star of three greater and six lesser points argent. Rank shall be differenced by braid.

**Oath of Service:** I herewith give my solemn oath to support the ideals, laws and traditions of our Society, Kingdom, and Barony; to faithfully carry out the duties of the Watch; and to seek opportunities to serve persons regardless of rank or estate as befits a Member of the Watch . Thus swear I, [name].

**Membership as a Halberdier:** A person applying for membership in The Watch as a Halberdier offers their service for at least one year. Members may resign without impunity from The Watch at any time after that year of service.

**Officers:** The term of service for Lieutenant or Captain is two years. Officers may reapply for one additional consecutive term (total of 4 years) if they so choose at an equal or higher rank. Officers may also serve for less than two years at their discretion or upon being relieved of their duties by the senior chain of command.

**Properties:** All items provided for the use of The Watch by the Barony, whether acquired by donation or by expenditure of Baronial funds, shall remain the property of the Barony and shall be returned thereunto upon request of any Baronial officer empowered to receive them.

Any items provided for the use of The Watch by any individual shall remain the property of that individual, and shall be surrendered thereunto upon demand.

**Payment of the Guard:** The Baron and Baroness are responsible for the payment of the Guard. This payment is to be made once a year at Stargate Baronial.

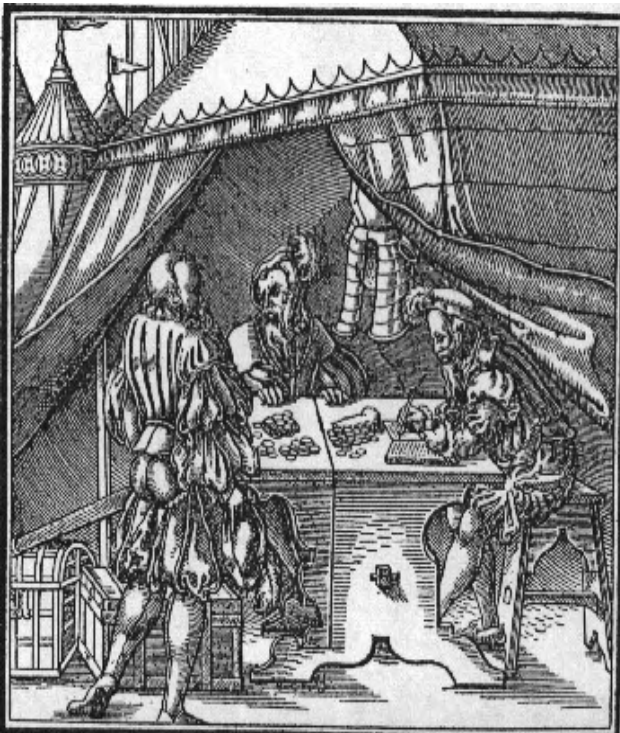
## Guardian of the Gauntlet XIII (and Guardian of the Glove III)

April 13-15, 2007

If you fight rapier, regardless of your level of experience, there is only one place for you to be on this particular spring weekend: Guardian of the Gauntlet XIII. The event will be held on the grounds of lovely Camp Camwood, located just northwest of Houston, where the camping is guaranteed, the list fields are spacious, the shade is plentiful, the camaraderie is assured, and the weather is perfect. But, in the most rare of circumstances, it sprinkles, there is a HUGE permanent covered pavilion that can hold 4 list fields and 200+ people, so the event is guaranteed, regardless of weather. In addition, as a special treat after Feast and Court, there will be a Hafla & Firespinning by Sir Corwin and crew. Fighting, Feast, Fire, and Fellowship. What more can one ask for?

**Tournament Format:** Triple elimination, wounds retained. Each round is a minimum of one Duel. Specifics: Every entrant to the Lyst receives two challenge coins. If you are killed or yield, you must give up one of the coins in order to fight in the next round. When you use a coin, all wounds are cleared. Once you use both coins, the Tournament is over for you. So, technically, you could use up both coins in the first round against a single opponent, although this is not recommended. Coins can be used only after a bout ends in a yield or death.

Approach this list as you would Queen's Champion. 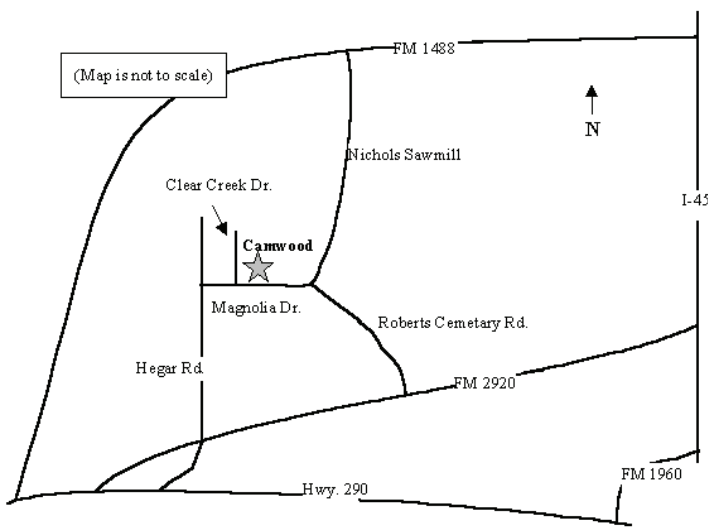

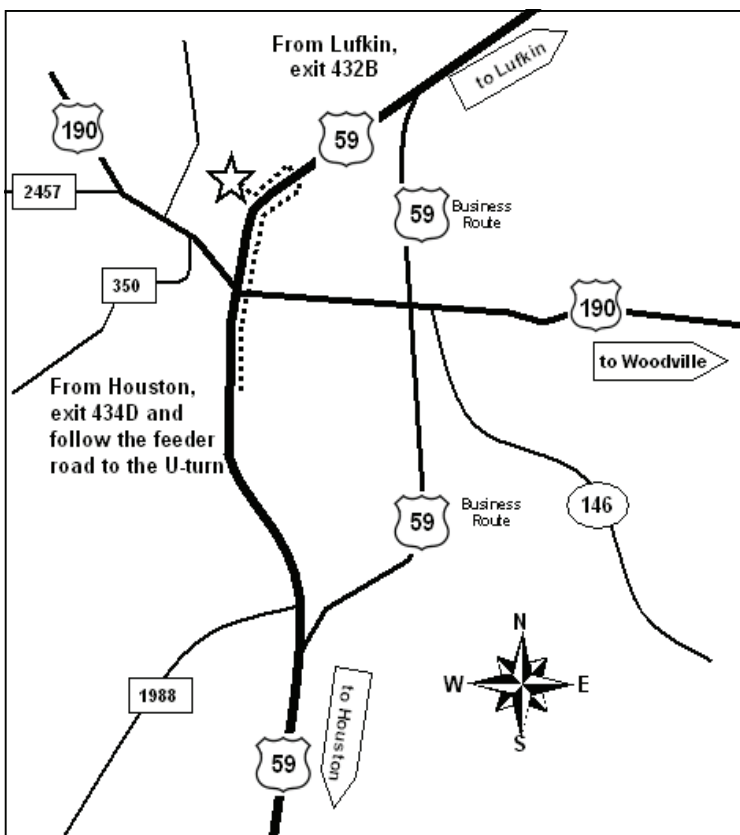
